When someone dies, the doctor who was treating them will issue a **Medical Certificate of Cause of Death**.

This certificate will be sent electronically direct to the Registrar.

If a death is sudden or the doctor is unavailable, it may not be possible for a Medical Certificate of Cause of Death to be issued. In this case, the death will be reported to the Coroner, which may lead to a delay in registering.

Registration should take place at a Registration Office in the District where the death occurred. However, it is possible to register from outside the area by 'declaration'. This process can take a few more days than usual and we will advise you of all the necessary steps.

ITEMS TO TAKE WITH YOU

The person registering must take proof of their own identification.

It is always useful (but not essential) to take the Birth Certificate and (if applicable) Marriage Certificate of the person who has died.

WHAT THE REGISTRAR WILL ISSUE

A GREEN CERTIFICATE (The Registrar's Certificate for Burial or Cremation)
The Registrar can send the Green Certificate directly to us by email if you give them permission to. This Certificate is not issued if the Funeral is a Cremation and a Post Mortem was held.

DEATH CERTIFICATES (A Certified Copy of the Entry)

The original entry in the Register is retained by the Registrar but you can purchase Certified copies at £11.00 per copy. These are required by Banks, Insurance Companies, Solicitors etc.

TELL US ONCE (please see separate page for an explanation of this) **You will also be offered use of the Tell Us Once service to notify Government Departments and Local Authorities**.

If this is not available, you will be offered a form called a BD8 which can be used to inform the Department for Work and Pensions.

If there is to be an Inquest and, therefore, you cannot register until after this has taken place, you can still ask the Registrar for access to Tell Us Once, once an Interim Death Certificate has been issued by the Coroner's Office.

We can guide you through all these processes.

TELL US ONCE

Tell Us Once is a service to help you give the information to the Department for Work and Pensions. They then pass the details to several other Government Departments and Local Authority services.

This scheme is only available within 28 days of receiving the unique reference number from the Registrar.

If there is an Inquest you can call the Registrar and they will give you the code for Tell Us Once before the Inquest is completed (but you will need to request an Interim Death Certificate from the Coroner's Office first).

Funeral Arrangements

As Funeral Directors, we will make all the funeral arrangements, as requested. We will guide you through all the options available to provide a completely individual service, tailored to your requirements. All types of religious and non-religious Services and Ceremonies are catered for.

We offer a completely confidential service at all times.

If the person dies in hospital

Contact us and all arrangements can then be made at your convenience.

If the person dies at home

Please inform the doctor immediately. The doctor or other medical professional can then attend and certify or verify the death.

We can then attend (at any time day or night) and bring the person into our care.

The Registrar

Once the necessary paperwork has been issued, an appointment to Register will be required. Full details can be found at the front of this booklet.

We will guide you through all the information required and assist you with making an appointment.

The Coroner

If the death is sudden or unexpected then the doctor must inform the police. They in turn report to the Coroner, who may request a post mortem. You should not be alarmed by this as, in most cases, it is only a formality.

We will liaise with the Coroner and advise you as necessary.

Charges

A written estimate will be forwarded to you after the funeral arrangements have been finalised. In most circumstances we do not require any payment in advance.

Chapel of Rest

Visits can be made to the Chapel of Rest by appointment.

Embalming

Embalming is the introduction of a preservative fluid using the circulatory system, to slow down the natural processes that occur after death.

Newspaper Notices

Announcements can be placed in local, national or online newspapers. We can advise on the wording and place the notice on your behalf.

Printing

Service Sheets and all types of personalised stationery are available on request.

Flowers

All forms of floral tribute can be ordered by us or by you contacting the florist personally.

Catering

We can help you arrange this in your own home or at a venue of your choice. In Bridport we have our own dining room, where refreshments can be served.

Donations to Charity

Company History

A. G. Down Funeral Directors in Bridport was established by Arthur Down on his return from WW2 and sold to **Eric Dunford** in 1979. Eric was joined by his wife, **Joyce**, in 1985. Eric was born in Bridport and Joyce in the Marshwood Vale; both have strong connections within the local communities. They were joined by Joyce's son, **Julian Hussey** in the early nineties, after he had gained his Diploma in Funeral Director and having worked in the Funeral Profession in various parts of the country.

Having worked closely with **W. G. Potter in Axminster**, the family purchased this business on the 1st January 1992. At that time the Funeral Director at W. G. Potter was helping **Overmass & Chapple in Seaton** as their Funeral Director was unwell. The owners wished to sell the business and the three combined in May 1992. When Laurence Richards retired he wished for the name **S. J. Richards & Son, Colyton** to continue its association with the Funeral Business. We helped him to achieve this by incorporating the name alongside that of Overmass & Chapple.

Julian & Karen met whilst studying to become members of the British Institute of Embalmers, as she was working as a Funeral Director in Hampshire at the time. They married in 1995 and after raising their children, Karen joined the firm on a full time basis.

In spring 1999 contact was made by the owners of **E. A. Dodd & Son in Honiton** who wished to sell their business and this was completed on the 1st June 1999.

Having helped many families with the Otter Valley, it became apparent that we needed to offer families a Funeral Home in **Ottery St. Mary.** Under the established name of **E. A. Dodd & Son** we opened here in December 2016.

We are fortunate to have been joined by Funeral Director, **Jerry Parkhouse** in January 2012. Jerry was born in Exeter and brought up in Exmouth. He has an extensive background of over 30 years in the funeral industry and is well known in the local area.

In 2019, local Funeral Director, **Darren Holt,** joined the team at A. G. Down. Darren is an experienced Funeral Director who obtained his BIFD Diploma in Funeral Services in 2016 and is well known in the local community.

Both Julian and Karen's children, **Jasmine and George**, have joined the business, ensuring that the family's care continues into the future. Jasmine joined the family business on a full time basis in December 2022 after working part time for a number of years, whilst working at The Melplash Show.
